USE THE DAY OF THE SHOW TO FIGURE THE AGE CLASS TO ENTER

The American Boer Goat Association, The Rockingham County Fairgrounds, or the Shenandoah Valley Showdown are responsible for any injuries to exhibitors, animals, spectators or personal property.

The 3rd Annual Shenandoah Valley Showdown is sanctioned by the American Boer Goat Association (ABGA). Please be familiar with the ABGA sanctioned show rules and regulations you may get a copy of these at www.abga.org or contact the American Boer Goat Association at 1207 S. Bryant Blvd, Suite C, San Angelo, TX 76903.

All goats must be ear tattooed, or scrapie tagged if unregistered, and have a current health paper (within 30 days of show); these will be checked when unloading. All goats must have registration papers/numbers; companion goats must have scrapie tags. Registration papers will be checked at show office when picking up show packet. **It is the owner's responsibility for ear tattoos to match registration papers and be done before entering ring. All goats brought to the show, except companions, must be entered in a class.**

*** Kids less than 3 months of age can be shown with a copy of the registration applications, stamped with the date received by one of the accepted breed associations. Exhibitors of animals over 3 months of age must have the original registration certificate in hand at the time of the show.**

*** Recognized breed associations are ABGA, IBGA & CBGA**

ALL ANIMALS MUST BE HEALTHY. No visible signs of abscesses or other contagious diseases (pinkeye, soremouth, ringworm, etc) will be allowed. In case of discrepancy, or for rules not adequately covered, **the show committee decision will be final.**

All entries MUST be on the ground by 7am the day of the show. The Barn will be open after 12 noon on Friday September 10, 2010. Check-ins are allowed between 12 noon and 9 pm on Friday and from 7 - 8 am on Saturday. All animals for the 1st shows must be checked in by 8am. IF coming in for 2nd show must be checked in immediately after 1st show concludes. If just coming in for Sunday must check in by 8am Sunday morning.

No animals are allowed to run free in the aisles, dogs must be leashed and respect other exhibitors and animals, not all are use to dogs.

Pens will be assigned. They are 5 x 5 board pens. **ONE PEN FEE APPLIES FOR THE WEEKEND.** IF exhibitors want to pen together, please advise on entry form. Exhibitors are responsible for bedding. Shavings will be available to purchase at the show if needed.
